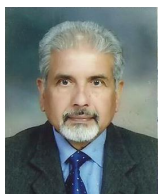
This year HARP only implemented the in hand projects and some other new projects received at the end of the previous year.

## Overview of year 2017-18

- Third external audit of Organic Farming Project, namely **“National Vegetable Initiative for Urban Clusters programme, Dhundan, District Solan”** was conducted by One Cert Asia, Jaipur in the month of April, 2017. The Certification Agency, Jaipur issued third scope certificates of organic status of rabi & kharif crops in favour of five Organic Grower Groups of the project.
- A training camp at Shiv Mandir Dhundan was organized on June 28, 2017 in which the registered organic growers were given Organic Farming Practices tips, ICS, Certification procedure & future action plan. The programme was also handed over to the Jaivik Agriculture Produce Marketing Society Ltd., Dhundan. With this event the National Vegetable Initiative for Urban clusters programme, Dhundan, District Solan (An Organic Farming Project) was closed.



- One day training on sensitization of the producers of the Taranda Valley Fruit & Vegetable Grower Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Village Chaura, district Kinnaur, H.P. was organized on the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2017. Total 16 producers were made aware about the importance and benefits of the Farmer Producer Organisation (FPO). Different activities which are to be carried out by the management of the Society were also discussed.





- Monitoring of Integrated Tribal Development Project (TDF project) in Rupri, Chhota Kamba and Nathpa panchayats of Nichar block, district Kinnaur was carried out by a team of NABARD, H.P. R.O., Shimla headed by the Chief General Manager, NABARD on 16-07-2017. The team randomly monitored a few wadi farmers of Chhota Kamba village. The water storage tanks constructed under this project were also inspected by the team. They also inspected the intercrop raised in the apple orchards.



- First experience sharing workshop for sharing the experience of farmers & the PIA in the implementation of the Integrated Tribal Development project in Rupri, Chhota Kamba and Nathpa Gram panchayats funded by NABARD under Tribal Development Fund (TDF) was held on 17-07-2017 in the Samiti Hall of Block Development Office Lutuska (Bhabanagar) under the chairmanship of Chief General Manager, NABARD, H.P. R.O. In this workshop the PIA presented the up to date physical & financial achievements vis-a-vis the targets envisaged in the DPR of the project on power point presentation. The problems being faced by the PIA in the implementation of the project were also highlighted and shared with the participating wadi farmers and the NABARD authorities. Total 36 wadi farmers participated in this workshop.



- One day training-cum-mobilization camp was organized by HARP for the Bhaba Valley Fruit & Vegetable Production & Marketing Cooperative Society, Katgaon, Kinnaur on 18-07-2017 at Katgaon. The producers were made aware about the benefits of FPO to the small & Marginal farmers and its importance in the present era. Different activities to be carried out by management of the cooperative society were also discussed.
- An exposure visit for 28 wadi farmers and farm women was organized on 4-8-2017 to the Progeny-cum-demonstration Orchard and Mushroom Training Centre & Khumb Khad Production Unit, Dutt Nagar, District Shimla. The farmers were exposed to the process of Khumb Khad production and progeny-cum-demonstration orchard.



- An exposure visit to Balindi Karsog Valley District Mandi (H.P.) for the producers of the Tranda Valley Fruit and Vegetable Growers Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Chaura, district Kinnaur was organized by HARP on 20-09-2017. Total 33 producers from FPO Chaura were exposed to the cultivation methods of growing of exotic vegetables by the farmers of Balindi. The farmers of FPO Chaura are new in the cultivation of exotic vegetables in their area.





- Skill development trainings on pruning, training & cutting of apple plants, apple orchard management & bee keeping were organized in the project area on 10-10-2017 to 13-10-2017. On 10<sup>th</sup> October, it was organized at village Majhgaon, gram panchayat (G.P.) Rupin, on 11<sup>th</sup> October it was organized at village Shigarcha, G.P. Rupin and on 12<sup>th</sup> October & 13<sup>th</sup> October at the villages Bara Kamba and Chhota Kamba respectively. DR. Gopal Thakur, DR. R.K. Sharma Scientists from the Regional Horticulture Research & Training Station and Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Sharboo & DR. K.D Verma (Retd.), Scientist of UHF Nauni District Solan and DR. R.S. Ratan, Chairman HARP were the resource persons. Total 32 wadi farmers at Majhgaon, 30 wadi farmers at Shigarcha and 26 wadi farmers at Bara Kamba participated in this training. The farmers were trained in the orchard management practices, importance of bee keeping in apple orchards & insect-pest management in apple orchards. Demonstration on cutting, pruning and training of apple plants was also given by DR. K.D. Verma.



- One day training in FPO management was organized by Producer Organisation Promoting Institute (POPI – HARP) on 17-10-2017 for the Board of Directors (BoDs) of the Shubham Fresh Vegetable Growers Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Galot, district Shimla. The BOD of this cooperative society (FPO) were trained in FPO Management practices.
- A meeting –cum –training of the Board of Directors (BoDs) of the The Maloothi Fruits, Flowers and Vegetable Growers Marketing Co-Operative Society Ltd. Maloothi, district Shimla was organized by POPI (HARP) on 26-10-2017 at Maloothi. Total 14 BODs and other producers were trained in office procedure

management, aggregation and marketing of the produce and input supply management to the producer members.



- A meeting – cum – training of the Board of Directors (BoDs) of the Shubham Fresh Vegetable Growers Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Galot was organized by POPI (HARP) on the 27-10-2017 at Galot. Total 9 members of BoDs and other shareholders were present in this meeting-cum-training. The BoDs were trained in the office procedure, aggregation of the produce of the producers and its marketing, input supply management, etc.
- Exposure visit to the MILCH livestock Improvement Society, Solan for the producers of the Shubham Fresh Vegetable Growers Marketing Cooperative Society Galot was organized by HARP on 18-11-2017. Total 15 producers of this FPO were exposed to the working and the management of the MILCH livestock improvement Society, Solan.



- An exposure visit for the producers of the The Maloothi Fruits, Flowers and Vegetable Growers Marketing Co-Operative Society Ltd. was organized by HARP on 18-11-2017 to the MILCH live stock improvement Society, Solan. Total 14 producers of this FPO were exposed to the working and management of the MILCH livestock Improvement Society.



- Exposure visit for the producers of The Sabzi Utpadak Cooperative Society Ltd. Bhanoti, district Mandi was organized by HARP on 21-11-2017 to MILCH Livestock Improvement Society Solan. Total 21 producers were exposed to the working and management of the MILCH Livestock Improvement Society.



- An exposure visit for the producers of the Devi Kot flowers, fruit & Vegetable production and marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Balindi was organized on 21-11-2017 by HARP to the MILCH livestock improvement society, Solan. Total 20 producers of FPO Balindi were exposed to the working and management of this MILCH Livestock Improvement Society.





- An exposure visit for the producers of The Bhaba Valley Fruit & Vegetable Production & Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd., Katgaon, district Kinnaur was organized by HARP on 22-11-2017 to the apple orchards of progressive growers of Thanadhar (Kotgarh), development block Narkanda, district Shimla. Total 15 producers of FPO Katgaon were exposed to the apple orchard management practices to be adopted for taking good yield of apple.



- An exposure visit for the producers of The Taranda Valley Fruit & Vegetable Growers Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Chaura (FPO Chaura) was organized by HARP on 22-11-2017 to the apple orchards of progressive growers of Thanadhar (Kotgarh), development block Narkanda, district Shimla. The producers of the FPO Chaura were exposed to the apple orchard management practices on farmers fields.





- One day training programme for Project Implementing Agency (PIA) Staff was held at Bhabanagar on 22-11-2017. The staff was trained in the activities of the project to be taken during the year.
- Skill development training on pruning, training & cutting of apple plants and apple orchard management and bee keeping was organized on 23-11-2017 at Nathpa village, G.P. Nathpa. DR. Gopal Thakur, DR. R.K. Sharma from Regional Horticulture Research & Training Station & KVK Sharboo, district Kinnaur and DR. R.S. Ratan, Chairman HARP were the resource persons. Total 50 wadi farmers from the village Nathpa participated in this training. The wadi farmers were trained in different activities of orchard management like preparation of basins, adding manures & fertilizer, painting of apple plant stems with the paste of copper chloride + water+ lime + flex oil, pruning & training, protecting apple plants from insect-pest infestation and importance of bee keeping in apple orchards.



- Project Monitoring & Review Committee (PMRC) meeting of The Bhaba Valley Fruit & Vegetable Production & Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. and The Taranda Valley Fruit & Vegetable Production & Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. was held on 6-12-2017 at the O/o the FPO Tranda Valley. The purpose of this meeting was to review the progress of both the FPOs and to discuss the future line of action. Total 11 members of FPO Bhaba Valley and 12 members of FPO Tranda Valley were present.



- A capacity building workshop on Animal Nutrition & Livestock Management was organized on 15-12-2017 at the Samiti Hall of Block Development Officer Nichar at Bhabanagar, district Kinnaur for the wadi farmers and farm women of Rupri, Chhota Kamba and Nathpa gram panchayats under TDF project. Total 23 farm women & farmers participated in this workshop. The farm women & farmers were trained in livestock management like balanced diet of milch & non milch cattle, design of cowshed, protective clinical vaccination against diseases to the livestock by Dr. Vikrant Thakur, Veterinary Officer Nigulsari and Dr. Ankit Karol, Veterinary Officer, Kaksthal, district Kinnaur. Shri. Paras Ram DDM (NABARD), Kinnaur at Reckong Peo presided over the workshop.



- A project Monitoring & Review Committee Meeting (PMRC) to review the progress of The Devi Kot Fruit, Flowers and Vegetable production and Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Balindi, district Mandi and The Sabji Utpadak

Cooperative Society Bhanoti, district Mandi was held on 26-12-2017 at Balindi. The progress of both the FPOs was reviewed and future plan of action was discussed. The DDM, NABARD, district Mandi Chaired the review meeting. Total 11 producers from Balindi & 9 producers from Bhanoti were present.

- After running the Umbrella Programme on Natural Resource Management (UPNRM) Project for 3 years, the Project was successfully completed during the year 2017-18 and a completion report was submitted to the NABARD on 23-08-2017. Out of Rs. 15.00 lakhs sanctioned as capital money by NABARD under this project as soft loan, an amount of Rs 8.00 lakh was only availed. This amount was repaid along with interest to NABARD fully by the end of completion of the project.



- Horticulture tools like secateurs, saw and grafting and budding knife with a pouch were distributed free of cost to the wadi farmers under TDF Project, district Kinnaur. The distribution programme was started on 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 from gram panchayat Chhota Kamba.





- Fourth experience sharing workshop under the Chairmanship of DDM (NABARD), district Kinnaur at Reckong Peo was held on 28-2-2018 at Samiti Hall at Bhabanagar to share the experiences of farmers and the PIA. Total 12 wadi farmers from Chhota Kamba Gram Panchayat participated in this workshop and were made aware about different provisions kept in the sanctioned Detailed Project Report (DDR) of TDF project.
- After Chhota Kamba Gram Panchayat, Horticulture tools were distributed to the wadi farmers of Ruppi Gram Panchayat on 10-03-2018 through Shri Paras Ram, DDM (NABARD), district Kinnaur. Total 130 farmers participated in this camp from Ruppi Gram Panchayat. The farmers were impressed upon the importance of training & pruning of apple plants.



- A 4 days skill development institutional training on pruning & training of apple plants was organized for 40 wadi farmers of three gram panchayats (Ruppi, Chhota Kamba & Nathpa) at Regional Horticulture Research & Training Station & KVK Sharboo, district Kinnaur from 16 to 19 January 2018. The skill of farmers in orchard management & pruning training was improved during these 4 days.





- Project Monitoring & Review Committee (PMRC) meeting was held on 6-1-2018 at Maloothi, to review the progress of The Maloothi Fruit, Flowers & Vegetable Production and Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Maloothi, district Shimla. Total 32 producers from FPO Maloothi participated in the review meeting. The progress of the FPO was reviewed and future plan of action was discussed.
- PMRC meeting was held on 3-3-2018 to review the progress of The Shubham Fresh Vegetable Growers Marketing Cooperative Society, Ltd. at Galot, district Shimla. Total 20 producers from FPO Shubham participated in the review meeting. The progress of the FPO was reviewed and future plan of action was discussed.



- A completion report of the National Vegetable Initiative for Urban Clusters programme, Dhundan, district Solan was submitted to the Deputy Director of Agriculture, Solan and the Subject Matter Specialist (SMS) Agriculture Kunihar along with a CD in which the detail of registered growers was loaded.



- Third party inspection report of Border Area Development Project was submitted to the NABARD Consultancy Services Pvt. Ltd. (NABCON), Shimla-9 on 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2018.



## Highlights of the year 2017-18

- Massive training programmes under different projects were conducted in the districts of Solan, Shimla, Mandi and Kinnaur of Himachal Pradesh.
- New programmes like experience sharing workshop of TDF project in district Kinnaur wherein farmers' organizations of the project, PIA and NABARD officers participated and shared their experiences regarding the implementation of the programme was organized. Organizing of gender sensitization programme under this project was also a unique experience for HARP.
- Organising farmers for specific purposes like input supply management, aggregation and marketing of produce of small and marginal farmers of Shimla, Mandi and Kinnaur districts was also a challenging programme for HARP which is being implemented successfully.

### जनजातीय विकास परियोजना किन्नौर के दुर्गम क्षेत्र के लोगों की बदल रही है आर्थिक तसवीर

एकीकृत जनजातीय विकास परियोजना के माध्यम से किन्नौर जिले के विभिन्न तहसीलों के दूरगम क्षेत्रों में रहने वाले लोगों की आर्थिक तसवीर बदलने की प्रगति देखी जा रही है। परियोजना के अंतर्गत नौ वर्षों में 44 लाख रुपये की सहायता से 643 परिवारों को 400 एकड़ भूमि को आधुनिक तकनीकों में तब्दील किया जा रहा है। अब तक नवागढ़ के सौजन्य से शिमला की हरकें संस्था ने रुपये, छोटा कम्बा व बाथपा पंचायतों के विकास कार्यक्रमों को तीन वर्षों में खेज, बहाकन, अखरोट व पुरी के 65 हजार से अधिक पौधे वितरित किये हैं, अब की पांच हजार लोटे जंगल विस्तारण किये जाने हैं। हरकें के अध्यक्षों की समीक्षा में दूर दराज जमीनों को आधुनिक बनाने की प्रगति में जमीनों की बंदि अधिक है लेकिन सम्पत्ति सरकारी बिचारे जंगल सहायता नकदक बन है। तीन बार को उस तीन पंचायतों के 15 गांव के विभिन्न तहसीलों में खुले लोगों को बागवानी में एक सिमर के माध्यम से विभिन्न क्षेत्रों से आये विशेषज्ञों ने कृषि और बागवानी से सम्बन्धित जानकारी दी। इस दौरान किसानों ने क्षेत्र के बागों को कैसे रखना बताया है, बागवानी से कैसे बागवानी करनी बताया। इस दौरान नवागढ़ के मुख्य मन्त्र प्रबन्धक, हरकें के सौजन्य आदर्शकाल व हरकें के परियोजना निदेशक डॉ. हरिंदर ठाकुर ने बताया कि रुपये, छोटा कम्बा और बाथपा पंचायत के लोगों की भागीदारी से एकीकृत जनजातीय विकास परियोजना शी तबने लगी है। लोगों ने विशेष निदेश के अनुसार जंगल बढ़ाया है। उल्लेखनीय है कि नवागढ़ के सौजन्य से करीब दस एकड़ की इस परियोजना में विभिन्न प्रकार की अकरा वाली सामग्री लाने को दी जा रही है और लोग सामुदायिक भवन से इन सामग्री को जंगल दे रहे हैं। जो हरिंदर ठाकुर ने बताया इन पंचायतों में लाने को क्षेत्र की रेल और रेल निदेश के पौधे दिए जा रहे हैं। अधिक ऊँचाई पर विशेषज्ञों की सहायता से पौधे लाने को 2014 से बांटे जा रहे हैं। उन्होंने बताया की लोगों को पौधे लाने के लिए तीन बार्ड तीन किट व गड्डा कपड़ों को देना है। उन्होंने बताया की लाने को सिंचाई सुविधा मुख्य कर्मचारी के लिए जंगल सहायता पर उनके का निदेश किया जा रहा है, उस के बाद पानी को स्टोरेज टैंक तक पहुंचाया जा रहा है वहां से आगे से जंगल के लिए निदेशों को देना है। उन्होंने बताया कि पौधे वितरित किये जा चुके हैं बांधि बांधे परिवारों को भी अन्य केलागोमुखी सहायता दी जा रही है। जहां की योजना में जंगल सौजन्य से अधिक भूमि बतें निदेश को भी पौधे दिए जा रहे हैं। उन्होंने बताया कि अन्य छोटे निदेशों को विभिन्न तरह के वेगवारी एवं अन्य कृषि से खुले सहायता दी जा रही है। उन्होंने बताया कि लोगों को नगुआली पालन, मत्स्य उद्योग, हल लकड़, लकड़ी उद्योग तथा विभिन्न बसेजमन से खुले प्रशिक्षण दिए जा रहे हैं। उन्होंने बताया कि दूर दराज के इन क्षेत्रों में बांधा ने बहुत बड़े लोगों को आर्थिक तसवीर बदलने का मौका उठाना है।
