Total strength of employees in HARP working in different schemes during the year was eleven. These employees worked in the implementation of Organic Farming Projects, TDF, FPO and UPNRM programmes. DR. Y.P. Sharma worked as a consultant under TDF Project. DR. R.S. Ratan, President gave over all guidance to the employees and also managed office as well as Society funds. Two employees worked in the management of HARP office.

Overview of year 2016-17

- A Project Monitoring and Review Committee (PMRC) meeting- cum- training for the Farmer Producer Organisation (FPO) – The Devi Kot Flowers, Fruit and Vegetable Production Cum Sale Cooperative Society Ltd. Balindi, district Mandi under the Chairmanship of District Development Manager NABARD, district Mandi was organized on 8th April 2016 at Balindi. In this meeting Agriculture Development Officer (ADO), Karsog, Manager, HP State Cooperative Bank Churag, Cooperative Inspector, Karsog, representatives from Producer Organisation Promoting Institute (POPI) & FPO were present. Total 25 participants were present in this training programme. In addition to training the progress of the FPO was also reviewed. Farmers were trained in the fundamentals of FPO & the need & importance of FPO(s) especially for small & marginal farmers.
- A PMRC meeting- cum- training for the The Subzi Utpadak Cooperative Society Ltd. Bhanoti, district Mandi under the Chairmanship of District Development Manager NABARD, district Mandi was organized on 8th April 2016 at Shiv Mandir Aashni, district Mandi. In this meeting Agriculture Development Officer (ADO), Karsog, Manager, HP State Cooperative Bank Churag, Cooperative Inspector, Karsog, representatives from POPI & FPO were present. Total 23 participants were present in this training programme. In addition to training the progress of FPO Subzi Utpadak was also reviewed. They were trained in the fundamentals of FPO and the need and importance of FPOs especially for small & marginal farmers. Representatives from a organic farming company were also present who emphasized the need of organic farming keeping in view the harmful effects of inorganic farming.
- One day training for the FPOs – The Tranda Valley Fruit and Vegetable Growers Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Chaura and The Bhaba Valley Fruit and Vegetable Production and Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd. Katgaon was organized on 13th April 2016 at Chaura and Katgaon, district Kinnaur (H.P.) in which 5 producers were trained at Chaura and 5 producers were trained at Katgaon.
- One day training programme on the package of practices of apple cultivation was organized on 28-4-2016 at gram panchayat Chhota Kamba under Integrated

Tribal Development Project (TDF Project) in Rupri, Chhota Kamba and Nathpa of Nichar block, district Kinnaur. In this training programme total 46 wadi farmers have actively participated who were trained in the best package of practices of cultivation of apple like basin preparation, manuring, pruning & training, irrigation, protection of the plants from the insect – pest attack, etc.

- Third external audit of National Programme for Organic Production (NPOP) Rajana under Organic Farming Programme was conducted by the Auditors of the OneCert Asia, Jaipur (Certification Agency) in the month of May, 2016. The Certification Agency issued third scope certificate having organic status in the name of M/s. Devbarah Organic Grower Group, Rajana, district Sirmour.
- A buyer-Seller meet under Organic Farming Programme was organized at Rajana, development block Sangrah, district Sirmour on 5-5-2016 for the marketing of organic produce of the area which has been converted organic by HARP. Total 12 participants from Rajana panchayat (sellers) and two participants from “2 Pure” company (buyer) participated in this meet. Detailed discussions between the buyer and seller were held and the issues like quality, procurement and the price of the produce were discussed. Later on HARP found that the agreement made during this meet did not materialize.
- Third external audit of NPOP Kathet, development block Bhatyat district Chamba under Organic Farming Programme was conducted by OneCert Asia (Certification Agency), Jaipur in May 2016. The Certification Agency issued third scope certificate having organic status in the name of M/s. Hathidar Organic Grower Group, Kathet, District Chamba.



- A meeting of villagers of Shigarcha village, G.P. Rupri was organized on 10-5-2016 in which a Village Planning Committee (VPC) under TDF project was formed. Total 7 farmers of this village were present.
- A meeting of villagers of Nalling village, G.P. Rupri was organized on 10-5-2016 in which a Village Planning Committee (VPC) under TDF project was formed. Total 13 farmers of this village were present.
- A meeting of farmers of Nalling II village, G.P. Rupri was organized on 11-5-2016 in which a Village Planning Committee (VPC) under TDF project was formed. Total 7 farmers of this village were present.
- A training programme for the FPO Shubham, Galot, district Shimla was organized on 14-5-2016 at village Galot in which 14 members were present. In this training the participating farmers were made aware about the fundamentals of FPO, its needs and importance to the small and marginal farmers of the State.



- A meeting of Project Monitoring and Review Committee (PMRC) under the Chairmanship of District Development Manager (NABARD) Shimla was held on 03-06-2016 at Galot in which 11 farmers, Agriculture Development Officer (ADO), Mashobra, Manager, HP State Cooperative Bank Ghanahati and representative from HARP were present. The committee reviewed the progress made by FPO Shubham.
- One day training programme on Organic Farming Practices for Kharif crops was organized on 11-06-2016 for Bania Devi and Jalpa Mata Organic Grower Groups (OGGs) at Durga Mandir Parisar, district Solan. Total 74 farmers and farm women from Bania Devi OGG and 95 farmers and farm women from Jalpa Mata

OGG participated in this training. The farmers and farm women were trained in organic farming practices and internal standard of organic farming. The methodology for the preparation of liquid manure like compost tea was also demonstrated. Organic inputs were also distributed to the registered farmers.



- One day training programme on organic farming practices for Kharif crops was organized on 12-6-2016 for Dev Dhar Organic Grower Group (OGG) at Aer and for Mandholi Deo Organic Grower Group (OGG) at Tiuru. Total 53 farmers and farm women from Dev Dhar OGG and 87 farmers and farm women from Mandholi Deo OGG were trained in organic farming practices including crop rotation and importance of leguminous crops in crop rotation and internal standards of organic farming. The method for the preparation of organic manure was demonstrated. Organic inputs were also distributed to the participants.



- One day training programme on organic farming practices for Kharif crops was organized on 13-6-2016 for Mansa Mata Organic Grower Group at Chamakhari

village in which total 57 farmers and farm women participated in this training. The farmers and farm women were trained in organic farming practices and internal standards of organic farming. The methods for the preparation of organic manure were demonstrated. Organic inputs were also distributed to the participants.

- A meeting of Project Monitoring and Review Committee (PMRC) under the Chairmanship of District Development Manager, NABARD, Shimla was held on 24-6-2016 at Maloothi to review the progress of FPO Maloothi. Total 31 farmers, Agriculture Development Officer (ADO), Mashobra, Subject Matter Specialist (SMS) Horticulture, Mashobra were present. In this meeting progress made by the FPO Maloothi was reviewed.



- A training – cum – workshop on Business Development Plan (BDP) was organized on 23-07-2016 at Dr. B. P. Pal Research-Cum –Study Center, IARI Regional Station, Shankali, Longwood, Shimla for the Board of Directors and CEOs of six FPOs promoted by HARP in Shimla, Mandi and Kinnaur districts. In this workshop the Business Development Plan (BDP) of these FPO(s) were discussed. Total 22 participants (Board of Directors and CEOs) participated in this workshop.



- To review the progress of FPO Shubham, a meeting of Project Monitoring and Review Committee (PMRC) under the Chairmanship of Manager, NABARD, HPRO, Shimla was held on 06-9-2016 at the O/o HARP at Dudhali, Shimla. Total 7 participants which include members of PMRC and representatives of FPO & POPI were present. In this meeting the progress of FPO Shubham was reviewed.



- To review the progress of the FPO Maloothi, a PMRC meeting under the Chairmanship of Manager, NABARD, HPRO, Shimla was held on 6-9-2016. In this meeting the progress of FPO Maloothi was reviewed. Total 7 participants which include members of PMRC and representatives of FPO and POPI were present.
- To review the progress of FPO Subzi Utpadak and FPO Devi Kot, district Mandi, a PMRC meeting under the Chairmanship of, DDM NABARD, district Mandi was held on 7-9-2016 at Balindi. The DDM Mandi reviewed the progress of both the FPOs. In the meeting ADO, Karsog, representatives of POPI and FPOs were present. Total 22 participants participated in this programme.



- Under the TDF Project, before procuring the apple nursery for the distribution to the wadi farmers, the nurseries of district Kinnaur were inspected by a committee constituted for this purpose. The nursery at Garshu was inspected on 1-10-2016 and the nursery at Powari was inspected on 30-9-2016 by the committee comprising DR. Y.P. Sharma, DR. Santosh and Shri Parmeshwar Negi.
- The 2nd external audit of National Vegetable Initiative for Urban Clusters programme, Dhundan, district Solan was conducted by the OneCert Asia (Certification Agency), Jaipur in the month of April, 2016. 2nd scope certificates of in conversion status of organic farming were issued to the five Organic Grower Groups (OGGs) of Dhundan area.



- 3rd external audit of National Vegetable Initiative for Urban Clusters Programme, Ganog, development block Sangrah was conducted by OneCert Asia (Certification Agency), Jaipur during July, 2016. Scope Certificates of organic status of crops was issued to two Organic Grower Groups (OGGs) of Ganog i.e., Vijat Maharaj OGG and Shirgul OGG.



- One day training programme on organic farming practices for Rabi crops was organized on 3-11-2016 for Dev Dhar Organic Grower Group (OGG) at Ghaturi and for Mandholi deo OGG at Tiuru. Total 53 farmers and farm women from Dev Dhar OGG and 87 farmers and farm women from Mandholi Deo OGG participated in this training programme. The farmers and farm women were trained in organic farming practices. The need for reviving old practices of mixed cropping, i.e. growing of gram with wheat crop and black gram with maize crop was emphasized to improve the soil health. The importance of pulse crop was highlighted by showing as how it fixes nitrogen in the soil from the atmosphere and improves the soil structure. The organic inputs and one tub for generating organic inputs were distributed to each registered farmers.



- One day training programme on organic farming practices for Rabi crops was organized on 4-11-2016 for Jalpa Mata OGG and Bania Devi OGG at Durga Mandir Parisar. Total 95 farmers and farm women from Jalpa Mata OGG and 74 farmers and farm women from Bania Devi OGG participated in this training programme. The need for reviving old practices of mixed cropping, i.e. growing of gram with wheat crop and black gram with maize crop was emphasized to improve the soil health. The importance of pulse crop was highlighted by showing as how it fixes nitrogen in the soil from the atmosphere and improves the soil structure. Organic input and one tub for generating organic input at farm level were distributed to each registered farmer.
- One day training programme on organic farming practices for Rabi crops was organized on 5-11-2016 for Mansa Mata OGG at Chamakhri village in which total 57 farmers and farm women were trained in organic farming practices. The need for reviving old practices of mixed cropping, i.e. growing of gram with wheat crop and black gram with maize crop was emphasized to improve the soil health.

The importance of pulse crop was highlighted by showing as how it fixes nitrogen in the soil from the atmosphere and improves the soil structure. Organic input and one tub for generating organic input at farm level were distributed to each registered farmer.



- Under TDF Project an exposure visit for 5 wadi farmers of Nathpa panchayat was organized on 12-11-2016 to the orchard and apple nursery of Shri Satya jeet Negi of village Powari district Kinnaur. Shri Satyajeet Negi is a progressive farmer of district Kinnaur. The wadi farmers were exposed to the best orchard management practices and growing of healthy apple nursery by the progressive farmer.
- Under FPO Proejct a mobilization – cum –training programme was organized on 18-11-2016 for the producers of the FPO – Devikot Flowers, Fruit and Vegetable Production cum sale Cooperative Society Ltd. Balindi. Total 15 producer members of this FPO were trained in different aspects of the FPO.
- One day sensitization training for the producers of the FPO – Sabji Utpadak Cooperative Society Ltd. Bhanoti was organized on 18-11-2016 at Bhanoti village. Total 25 producer members of the FPO were present. In this training the progress of this FPO was reviewed in addition the producers were mobilized to promote and support the FPO, so that it becomes a strong Institution and the producers are benefitted. Different activities to be carried out by FPO were finalized along with time line.



- Under TDF Project an exposure visit for 9 wadi farmers of Rupri gram panchayat was organized on 22-11-2016 to the orchard and nursery of a progressive farmer Shri Satyajeet Negi at Powari, district Kinnaur. The farmers were exposed to the best orchard management practices and growing of health nursery of apple fruit plants.
- The evaluation of Project “Rural economic empowerment & employment generation through animal waste management” was started on December 2, 2016. The detail studies for evaluating the project at Baddi was carried out on December 7, 2016. The report was submitted on March 16, 2017 to the Animal Husbandry Department through NABCONS, HPRO Shimla-9.



- One day PIA staff training under TDF Project was organized on 12-12-2016 in the Field office of HARP at Bhabanagar. Total 4 staff members of TDF project were trained in the activities of the Project.

- Under FPO Project, a 3 days capacity building – cum training programme was organized from 20 to 22 December 2016 for the Board of Directors (BoDs) of six FPOs promoted by HARP at Agriculture Cooperative Staff Training Institute (ACSTI) Shangti, Summer Hill, Shimla. Total 33 members (BoDs) of six FPOs and 3 members of HARP actively attended this programme.



- Under TDF Project a training programme on the preparation of vermicompost was organized on 30-12-2016 at Shigarcha village, GP Rupri, district Kinnaur. Total 30 wadi farmers were trained in the methods of preparation of vermicompost. A practical exposure of training and pruning of apple plants was also given to the participating farmers.



- Under TDF Project a training programme on preparation of vermicompost and training and pruning of apple plants was organized on 21-12-2016 for the wadi farmers of GP Rupri at village Majhgaon. Total 42 farmers and farm women participated in this training wherein the expert of HARP demonstrated the

method of preparation of vermi compost and also given practical training on training and pruning of apple plants.



- Under TDF Project a training programme on preparation of vermicompost and training and pruning of apple plants was organized on 24-12-2016 for the wadi farmers of GP Chhota Kamba at Chhota Kamba village. Total 54 wadi farmers have actively participated in this training wherein the expert of HARP demonstrated the method of preparation of vermicompost and also given practical training on training and pruning of apple plants.



- The HARP Shimla sponsored five CEOs of five FPOs for three months training to Uuva Mitra / Training Center Nashik, Maharashtra w.e.f 26-12-2016 to 01-03-2017. The CEOs were given theoretical training at the training institute Nashik which was supported with the field studies and report writing.
- One day training programme on organic farming practices for Kharif 2017 was organized on 15-02-2017 for Dev Dhar OGG at Aer village and Mandholi Deo OGG at Tiuru village. Total 53 farmers and farm women from Dev Dhar OGG and 87 farmers & farm women from Mandholi Deo OGG were trained in the organic farming practices. The detailed procedures for certification and adoption of

internal standards of organic farming were also explained to the participants. Organic inputs were distributed to each registered grower of these groups.



- One day training programme on organic farming practices for Kharif 2017 was organized on 16-02-2017 for Jalpa Mata OGG and Bania Devi OGG at Durga Mandir Parisar Dhundan. Total 95 farmers and farm women from Jalpa Mata OGG and 75 farmer and farm women from Bania Devi OGG were trained in organic farming practices. Detailed procedure for certification and adoption of internal standards of organic farming were explained to the farmers. Organic inputs were distributed to each registered growers.



- One day training programme on organic farming practices for kharif 2017 was organized on 17-02-2017 for Mansa Mata OGG at Chamakhri village. Total 57 farmers and farm women were trained in general organic farming practices. Detailed procedure for organic certification and adoption of internal standards of organic farming were also explained to the participants. Organic inputs were also distributed to each registered growers.



- The Organic Farming Projects namely National Vegetable Initiative for Urban Clusters Programme Ganog and NPOP Rajana, development block Sangrah, district Sirmour were completed during the year 2016-17. Completion reports of both the Projects were submitted to the Deputy Director of Agriculture, Sirmour in September, 2016. The programmes were handed over to a registered Society namely, "The Jaivik Krishi Avam Gramin Vikas Society, Rajana-Ganog.



- The Organic Farming Project (NPOP) of Kathet, development block Bhatyat, district Chamba was completed during 2016-17. Completion report of the project was submitted to the Deputy Director of Agriculture, Chamba and the Hathidhar Organic Grower Society, Kathet (a registered Society).



- The training of ICS Staff of HARP on Internal Control System (ICS) was held on 18/02/2017 in the Office of HARP at Thakur Niwas, Dudhali, PO Bharari, Shimla. Total 9 members of ICS Staff of HARP have actively participated in this training.



- Under the project “Establishment of Virus Free Elite Mother Block of Apple in the Tribal area of Kinnaur”, the farmers of Development block Nichar and Kalpa were mobilized by HARP to participate in the Apple Contest during the year 2016-17.
- One day buyer–seller meet for the marketing of vegetable, cut flowers and fruits was organized by HARP on 19-3-2017 under FPO programme funded by NABARD at DR. B.P. Pal Research-Cum-Study Center, IARI Regional Station Shankli, Longwood Shimla. Total 39 buyers and sellers and 4 members of HARP participated in this meet. The problems being faced by buyer and sellers were discussed in detail. The buyers explained to sellers the importance of grading and packing for getting best prices.



- NABARD organized a workshop on water conservation on 22-03-2017 on the occasion of water conservation fortnight. DR. R.S. Ratan, President HARP gave a power point presentation on water conservation to the participants. The participants were officers from different departments and banks.

Highlights of the year 2016-17

- Massive training programmes under Integrated Tribal Development Project (TDF), Organic Farming and Farmers Producer Organization (FPO) schemes were organized during this year.
- HARP was conferred on third best Producer Organization Promotion Institute (POPI) by NABARD, Shimla for 2016-17 for the promotion of six FPOs in Himachal Pradesh. A trophy was given to HARP as an award.
- The President HARP was especially invited to give a power point presentation on “Water Conservation” in a workshop organized by NABARD on the occasion of celebration of “Water Conservation Fortnight” at National level. HARP also published a pamphlet on “Water Saving” and distributed to the farmers in all training camps organized by HARP during 2016-17.

Ltd. (NABCONS) on 7-12-2016.
